Early Childhood Education

The Early Childhood Education (ECE) program offers a dynamic approach to those interested in educating children and incorporates key elements of *Capable, Confident, and Curious: Nova Scotia's Early Learning Curriculum Framework*. Students encounter an educational experience that offers both academic and practical components throughout the duration of the accelerated one-year diploma program. Students enrolled in the program will learn to view children as diverse learners who can gain great traction through natural discovery and invention in holistic, play-based learning environments. Students will learn to value the social and cultural contexts of children, the continuity of learning experiences, and authentic assessment.

Career Options: Graduates are qualified to work with infants, toddlers, preschoolers, and school-aged children in licensed childcare settings, pre-primary, school-age programs, Head Start, family resource outlets and child development centers within early intervention and public health services. Many graduates find work providing childcare in private homes, as well as operating in-home day-cares.
